The Notre Dame High School Distinguished Scholars Program

On the basis of the entrance exam, elementary/middle school achievement, teacher recommendations, and personal interview, a select number of first-year applicants will be invited to pursue their four-year high school education as Notre Dame Distinguished Scholars. This High Honors Program is grounded in a challenging and diverse curriculum, featuring interdisciplinary inquiry, independent initiative, and a commitment to academic excellence. Studying and learning together in this small group, a community of scholarship and intellectual curiosity will be prepared, on a more advanced level, for future studies and opportunities in higher education. Distinguished Scholars are also eligible to participate in a two-week International Study Program in Oxford, UK in the summer following either their sophomore or junior years.

Students and parents will be contacted to schedule an interview. The Director of the **Distinguished Scholars Program** will contact parents using the email address included on this application. Please note that parents will attend this interview but questions will be directed to the student.

Deadline

Applications must be received in their entirety by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, November 17, 2023.

Scholarship Information

Students invited to participate in the **Distinguished Scholars Program** will be awarded an academic scholarship. The amount of this scholarship will be determined by the entrance exam results and seventh/eighth-grade academic achievement. If awarded a scholarship, students will be expected to maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher with no *final* grades below 80 while at Notre Dame. Failure to do so may result in the revocation of any scholarship. In addition, students will be expected to fully participate in the **Distinguished Scholars Program** to continue to receive their academic scholarships. Families may also qualify for need-based financial aid.
